### Let's Get Started

Every state has their own license plate designs. See if you can find license plates from all the 50 states! Of course, you may decide to keep it down to the 48 contiguous states because Alaska and Hawaii are too far away. Or you can look for 49 by including Alaska - it's up to you!

Make a list of all the states and check off each state as you find it on the cars around you. Or make several copies of the list, and every time you cross over into a new state, start over to see which state has the largest variety of travelers in it.

These are just a few of the license plate games you can play, but you can also make up your own game.

There are endless games to play with license plates, car makes, models and colors. It's a great way to keep everyone involved in your journey while keeping peace in the backseat... so good luck and happy license plate hunting!

### **License Plate Numbers Game**

Can you find license plates with consectutive numbers?

### What You Will Need

### Let's Get Started

Here is a game you can play on vacation, or any other time. Many license plates have either a three- or four-digit number on them. Look for a license plate that begins with 001 or 0001. When you see it, call out so that others can verify. You have to act fast so that someone else in your car can see it before it goes away. Once you've seen 001 (or 0001) and it's been verified by someone else in the car, then it's time to look for 002 (or 0002).

This game has the advantage of taking a long time. You can invent your own variation of the game by making special rules, like choosing a random three-digit number and making that a "wild-card", or deciding that if you see three license plates with the same number you get to skip ahead one. (In other words, if you're having trouble finding 002 but you see three 001s you get to skip ahead to 003).

More advanced riders can look for the sequence of prime numbers, (001,003,005,007,011,013, ,etc.)

At the end of your day, don't forget to write down the number you are looking forso that you don't forget where to start when you get back in the car.

This is a fun game, but it does take quite a bit of patience. For younger riders there is a slightly easier game...

#### Let's Get Started

Here's an easy game for passengers who are working on their alphabetizing skills: look for a sign that begins with each letter in the alphabet. So, first you look for a sign that starts with the letter "A". Then, you move through the alphabet as you find signs that start with each letter alphabetically. The rule is that the first word in the sign has to start with the letter you need. For older riders, start with "Z" and work backwards to "A".

The Alphabet Game is fun and can go pretty quickly (except for X and Z!). Here's another game that works especially well for long trips on the highway

Within a decided game period, each player looks for and marks off the items they they see on their Bingo sheet. The first player to get 5 items in a row, in any direction, wins.


















