It's easy to create wall decor that also functions as a learning tool.




























What You Will Need


Pen/Markers

Note: This activity involves using scissors. Have an adult cut out the templates for any little ones.


Creating Your Bug Facts

2. Cut along the dotted lines on the template.







3. Write a fact about each bug on their individual fact cards.





4. Place the bugs together on one wall or bulletin board. Then put the bug facts next to those in a column of their own.


Have the students match the facts to the correct bugs.










Classroom Decorating Ideas

What You Will Need

Hammermill® Premium Laser Print 24LB Paper (P.S. You can cut out the butterfly on the ream) Glue Scissors Pen/Markers Notebook/Folder

Note: This activity involves using scissors. Have an adult cut out the templates for any little ones.

Creating Your Name Cards

1. Print out the name card templates.



2. Cut along the dotted lines on the template.



3. Fill in the cards with name, class, year and any other necessary information.



4. Take the pieces you cut out and apply glue to the blank sides. Make sure to cover the entire surface evenly.




5. Decorate notebooks and folders.


















Tape

Creating Your Tiled Bug Poster


1. Print out the tiles for the poster.




2. Cut along the dotted lines on the template. Be careful not to cut off the white "overlap."




3. Tape the back of the tiles so that they overlap the white areas and the graphics align perfectly on the front of the poster.











CATERPILLAR




As caterpillars grow, they shed their skin, or molt. They can do this up to six times in their lifetime.
