

Kindness Envelopes

Glue


Scissors

Optional: Push Pins


Note: This activity involves using scissors. Have an adult cut out the templates for any little ones.

Creating Your Envelopes


1. Print out the patterned envelope templates, or have fun making your own designs.




2. Cut around the template along the line given.




3. Flip the paper around so that the printed pattern is facing down.




4. Fold the left flap back towards you along the dotted lines, so that the pattern is now on the outside of the fold.




5. Repeat step 4 with the right flap.




6. Carefully fold the bottom flap over the side flaps and glue down in place.



7. Fold the top flap down.




8. Pin the envelope to a board, or stick it up on the wall. Have fun writing secret compliments to your classmates!





Glue





Creating Your Job Chart


1. Print out the patterned job templates, or design your own.




2. Print out the colored name tags or decorate your own with the blank template given.

4. Cut out the name tag templates along the outline.




5. Pin or glue the jobs to a board or the wall. Arrange them on colored bulletin board paper for an added layer of fun.

















Create your own fun banner! With every letter of the alphabet included as a template, you can make a banner for any festivity.




What You Will Need

String


Note: This activity involves using scissors. Have an adult cut out the templates for any little ones.

Creating Your Banners


1. Print out the colored letters given, or color in your own.




2. Cut out the triangles around the outline.




3. Measure and cut the string. Make sure to leave enough string to tie at the ends.



4. Fold the top of the triangle backwards along the dotted line.



5. To attach the string to the banner, flip the triangles around, fix the string under the folded flap and glue in place.



6. Lay the triangles out in order to form different words and phrases. Glue them down in place. Hang it up on the wall or a board, and you have your own custom banner.
