Halloween Pumpkin Carving Templates

Get into the Halloween spirit by carving a pumpkin with one of our spooky templates. The included templates are a bit more frightening than your average jack-o-lantern.

Templates Include:

- 6 Ghosts**
- 8 Monsters**



Spooky Ghosts and Scary Monsters!

Add some Halloween spirit to your house with our easy-to-use carving templates. Carve a ghastly ghost or menacing monster to help get your home Halloween ready.

What you will need:

Hammermill® Paper
A pumpkin
Tape
A carving knife/Pumpkin carving kit
Newspapers or a garbage bag
A big spoon
A jar lid
A large candle

Note: This activity involves using a sharp knife and burning candle. It is probably best conducted by an adult under the careful supervision of a young one.



Let's get started.

Grab your pumpkin and supplies.



- 1 Print out the pumpkin carving template you would like to use.
- 2 Place a newspaper or garbage bag under your pumpkin.
- 3 Use a carving knife to cut around the stem at the top of the pumpkin. Be sure you cut the hole large enough so you can fit your hand in.
- 4 Hold the pumpkin stem firmly while you pull the top of the pumpkin off the base.





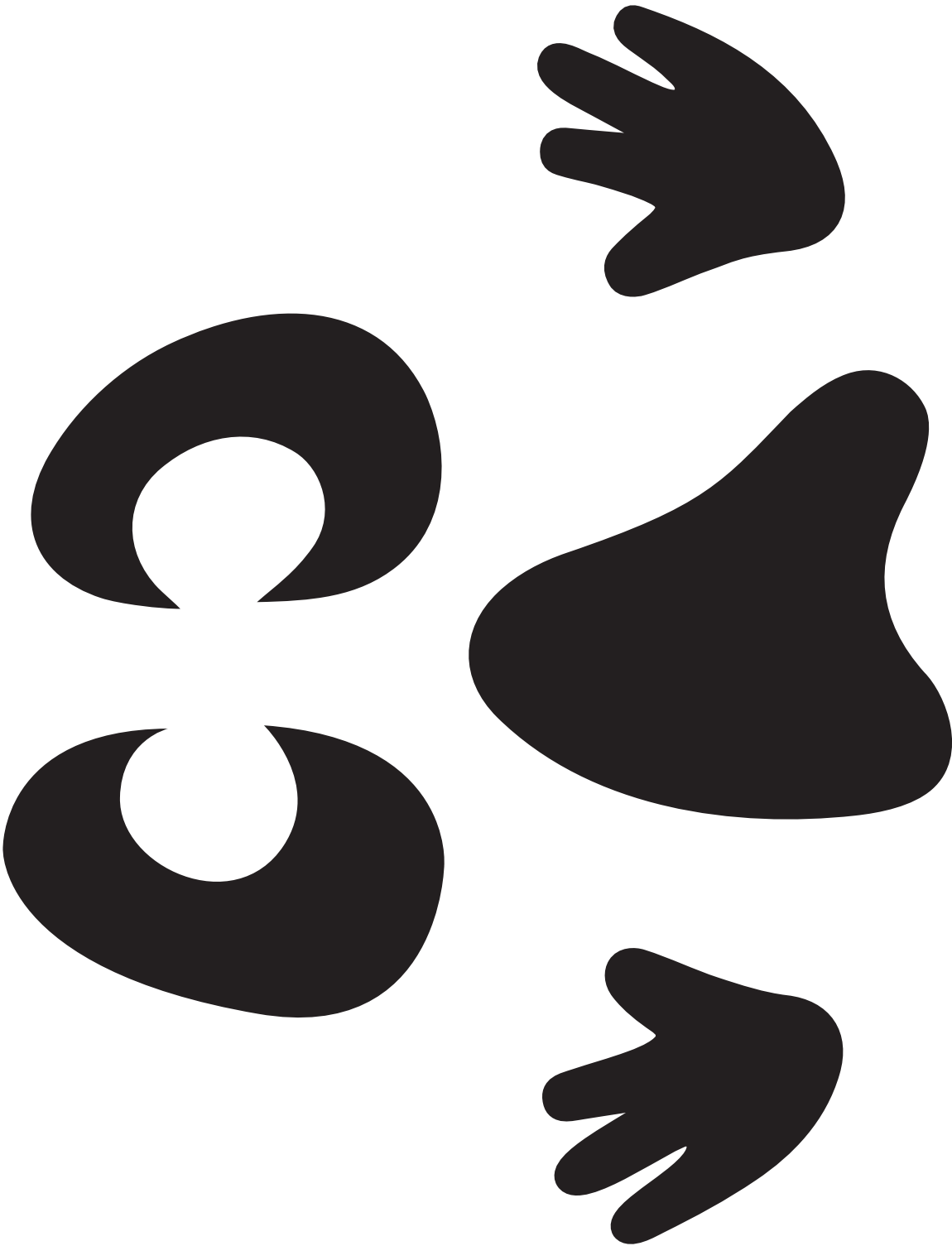
- 5 Scrape the bottom of the pumpkin and remove the pumpkin seeds and pulp.
- 6 Make sure the pumpkin is scraped clean. **Tip:** Use an ice cream scoop.
- 7 Cut a notch out of the pumpkin lid so the candle can breathe.
- 8 Pat the inside of your pumpkin with a paper towel to help keep moisture out. **Tip:** Use the seeds and pulp in a pumpkin recipe.



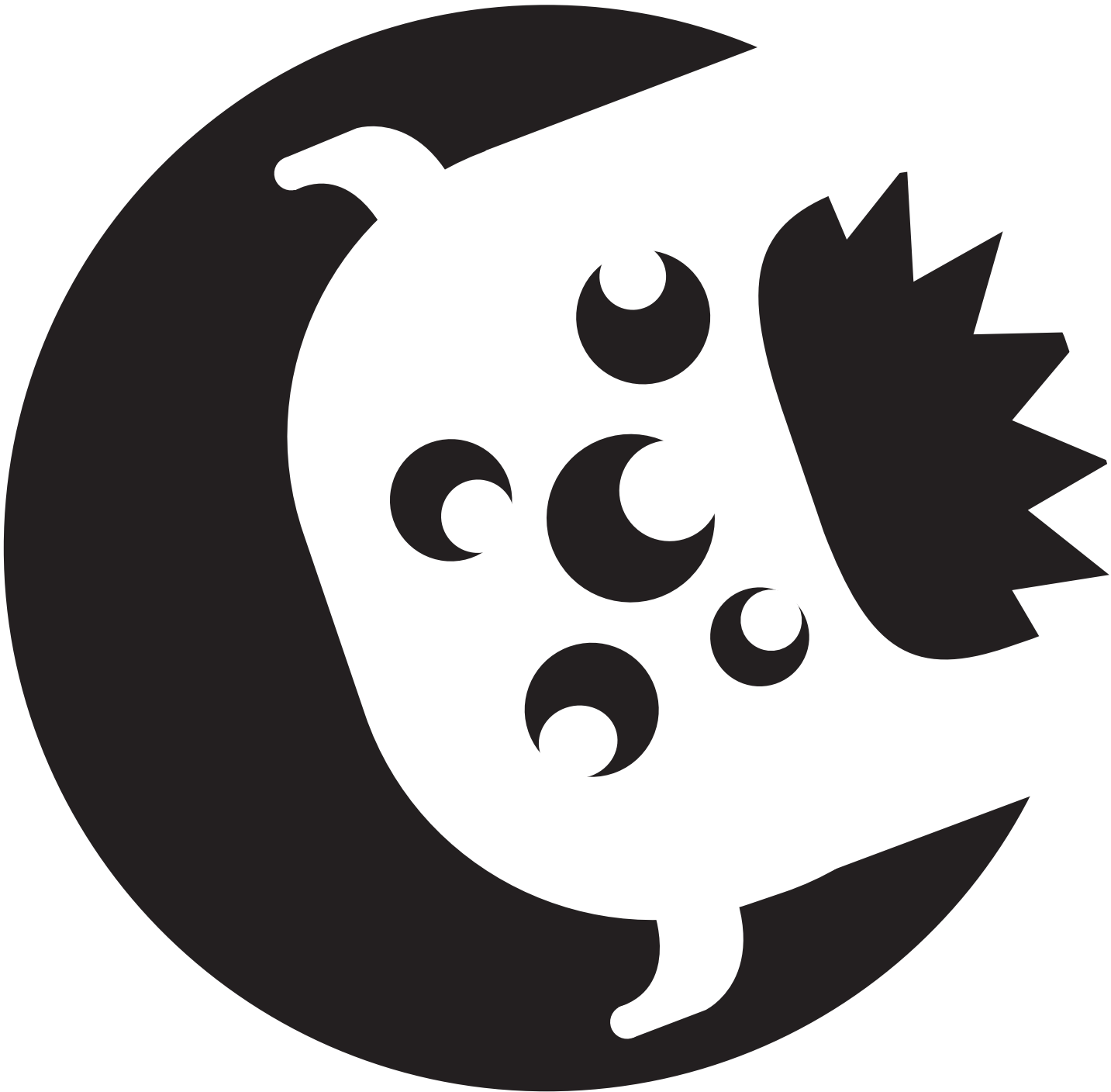


- 9** Now it's time to carve.
- 10** Tape the template you would like to use to the front of the pumpkin.
- 11** Use your knife to cut around the template.
- 12** Find a safe spot to place the pumpkin, away from anything flammable.
- 13** Take a candle and place it at the bottom of the pumpkin.
- 14** Light the candle and enjoy.
