

Every day can be a snow day! Bring a little cheer to your winter by making your very own paper snowflakes.




Snowflakes



Folding Instructions for Card, Rabbit, and Bear Snowflake Templates




Step 1

Print out the following templates to create your snowflakes. Place the template in front of you, face up.



Step 2

Fold the paper in half length-wise, so that you can see the HAMMER-MILL logo in the upper right corner.



Step 3

While folded, fold the sheet of paper in half or along the bottom edge of the pattern.



Step 4

Fold the outer bottom edge up and diagonally so what was the bottom edge of the rectangle now aligns with the left edge.



Step 5


Fold the outer bottom edge up and diagonally so what was the bottom edge of the rectangle now aligns with the left edge.



Step 6

Open your snowflake. Repeat with other ideas and templates to make your own winter wonderland.


Template: Card Symbols



Template: Rabbit




Template: Bear




Folding Instructions for the 12 Point Snowflake



Step 1Place the template in front of you, face up.



Step 2
Fold the paper in half lengthwise, so that you can see the HAMMER-MILL logo in the upper right corner.



Step 3
While folded, fold the sheet of paper in half or along the bottom edge of the pattern.



Step 4
Holding the middle left center of the paper, fold the top left corner down about 30°.
Make sure the left center point stays at the center.



Step 5
Unfold the fold just created. Again, holding the middle left center of the paper, fold the top left corner down to make a 60° fold this time.



Step 6
This will be repeated to the bottom rectangle.
With the paper folded at the 60° fold, fold over the 60° fold edge to align with the left edge of the bottom vertical rectangular portion of the folded paper.



Step 7
Flip your folded piece of paper over. Now fold in half so that the longest edges align.




Step 8
If the pattern is not on the outside, open and refold as needed. Finally, cut out the pattern. Hold the paper tightly as you cut to prevent the folded layers from sliding.



Step 9
Open your snowflake.
